

Colors you can find in the Old German Owls.



Red - Shield Mark
Base color is ash red, and the pattern T-pattern.



Cream - Shield Mark
Cream is an ash red base color, with spread. It is one of the many color variants that come from ash red and spread. Cream requires dilute as well.



Black - Shield Mark
Blacks are made up of the base color blue/black with the spread gene. They can be any pattern, check, bar, or T-pattern. The base pattern does not appear to make any difference in the black.



Red Bar
This red bar from the show, is base color ash red, pattern bar. The bird does not have spread nor dilute. When you add dilute you get the cream bars.



Yellow - Shield Mark
Yellow is made with the base color of ash red, and the pattern is T-pattern, just like the red. The gene for dilute is added to make the yellow. Neither red nor yellow carry the gene for spread.
